CUTTING COMPETITORS

- * All participating owners and riders must be members of the National Cutting Horse Association (NCHA). Please submit a photocopy of all required NCHA membership cards (owner and rider).
- * NCHA rules for judging will be followed.
- * By signing the entry form all cutting competitors confirm that they possess a current NCHA membership and all non pros confirm that they possess a current NCHA non pro card.
- * A horse may be entered in either or both Open and Non Pro with the same or a different rider in each division.
- * Practise cattle (in the outside practise pens): Fresh cattle will be available Saturday, September 24th at 1:00 p.m., Cost is \$80 for 5 minutes (minimum 5 minutes), fresh cattle practise works must be paid by September 1st. Used cattle (when available) – cost is \$40 for 5 minutes (maximum 5 minutes). Sign up for the practise pen when you arrive in Red Deer. Please have a signed blank cheque payable to the Canadian Supreme to hand to practise pen personnel the first time you enter the practise pen. One practise flag will be available on the grounds and will be supplied by the Canadian Supreme. No other practise flags will be permitted anywhere on the Westerner grounds.
- * All cutting classes will be supplied with three head of fresh cattle per work.
- * All cutting classes with 2 gos and a finals – only the top 70% will advance to the 2nd go.
- * All cutting finalists will be charged \$100 for cattle for the finals (cattle fees will be taken from payouts).
- * Judges scores of 120 or less will not advance to the next go.
- * **Cutting Cross Entries** will pay the full add back and full office & cattle fee for the first class entered and full add back and \$95 for office & cattle fee for the second class entered.

COW HORSE COMPETITORS

- * Cow Horse competitors will run Alberta Reined Cow Horse Association (ARCHA) patterns.
- * By signing the entry form all non pro competitors confirm that they qualify as an ARCHA Non Pro.
- * Snaffle Bit and Hackamore classes are herd, rein, and fence. Bridle classes are rein and fence.
- * 4 and 5 year olds may show in either the hackamore or the bridle class, but not in both classes.
- * Limited Open Snaffle Bit class: you must be entered in the Open or CS Open Snaffle Bit class to be eligible to enter.
- * ARCHA rules for judging will be followed.
- * **RENO RIDER EXCEPTION:** The Canadian Supreme will provide a Reno Rider Exception for the 2011 show to cow horse competitors that want to show at the Canadian Supreme in Red Deer but would also like to show at the NRCHA Snaffle Bit Futurity in Reno. - * **Cow Horse Cross Entries** will pay the full add back and full office & cattle fee for the first class entered and full add back and \$95 for office & cattle fee for the second class entered.

REINING COMPETITORS

- * American Quarter Horse Association (AQHA) patterns will be used for all classes.
- * Proper Western attire, including cowboy hat, cowboy boots, long sleeve button up shirts and denim jeans, must be worn in the competition pen at all times.
- * If a rider rides more than one horse in a class, wherever possible, there will be a spread of at least 8 horses between his/her runs.
- * All non pro reining competitors will be asked to sign a Non Pro Declaration at the Canadian Supreme show office.
- * The AQHA Rules for Reining, section #451 in the AQHA Official Handbook will be used. Any discrepancies will be dealt with by Canadian Supreme show management and all show management decisions are final.
- * Canadian Supreme earnings, in the limit classes, are as of December 31, 2010. A list of ineligible riders will be posted on the website at www.canadiansupreme.com. Limited open classes are intended for riders with limited earnings. If you do not have Canadian Supreme earnings the Canadian Supreme show management will review lifetime earnings and decide eligibility.
- * **All reining classes are one handed except for the 3 year olds classes (CS Open and Non Pro Reining Futurities, Open & Ltd. Open Reining - 3 year olds, and Non Pro Reining - 3 year olds).**
- * A limited number of private paid warm-ups are available to reining competitors on Wednesday PM. Get your entries in early, 120 paid warm-ups slots will be available on a first entries received basis. A maximum of two paid warm-ups per horse. Times will be scheduled by show personnel. The paid warm-up schedule will be posted on the website: www.canadiansupreme.com by Monday, September 19, 2011. You are responsible for making sure you are there at your scheduled time.

REFUND POLICY

If an entry is cancelled, all fees will be forfeited. No refunds shall be given except in the event of the death or a disabling injury to a horse. The owner of said horse must provide written verification of such from a Veterinarian. Any veterinary fees will be the responsibility of the horse owner. If the owner provides written verification after September 1st but prior to the draw, the owner will be refunded half of the office fee, and half of the cattle fee. **After the draw, no refunds will be given.** Failure to meet the above requirements will result in forfeiture of all entry fees.

SUBSTITUTION POLICY

After the September 1st deadline an injured horse may be substituted within the class if written verification from an approved Veterinarian is received and a \$100 substitution fee is paid. The substituted horse must belong to the same owner and a copy of the registration certificate must be provided. If the substitution is received after the draw but prior to the start of the event the substituted horse will work in the original draw position.

TIE BREAKERS

#1 In the event of a first place tie, the horse with the highest fence work will be declared the Champion. If there is still a tie, a compulsory ride-off of the fence work will determine the champion.

#2 In the event of a first place tie, a ride-off will determine the Champion.

#3 Any ties for first place will be worked off if the tied exhibitors both agree to participate in a run-off. If they do not agree, the exhibitor who does not want to run-off will forfeit first place to the other.
