

RENO RIDER EXCEPTION
For Finalists of the NRCHA Snaffle Bit Futurity

As a pilot project, the Canadian Supreme will provide a Reno Rider Exception for the 2010 show to cow horse competitors that want to show at the Canadian Supreme in Red Deer but would also like to show at the NRCHA Snaffle Bit Futurity in Reno.

The following rules will apply:

1. You must enter the Canadian Supreme by September 1, 2010 and pay all fees by September 1, 2010.
2. You must declare by September 1, 2010 which horses could be withdrawn due to the rider competing at the NRCHA Snaffle Bit Futurity.
3. If the open rider competes in the NRCHA Snaffle Bit Futurity finals then a replacement rider may be substituted for the Canadian Supreme entries at no cost.
4. If the rider competes in the NRCHA Snaffle Bit Futurity finals and a replacement rider is not used then the rider may withdraw all declared entries and all fees for the Canadian Supreme entries will be returned except for the office fee.
5. If the rider does not compete in the NRCHA Snaffle Bit Futurity finals or the Canadian Supreme classes and a replacement rider is not used then all Canadian Supreme fees will be forfeited.
6. It is the responsibility of the rider (with horses declared for the Reno Rider Exception) to notify the Canadian Supreme show office at phone #403-831-3221 as to the status of the entries. Non Pro riders by Sunday, September 26th and Open riders by Tuesday, September 28th. If the Canadian Supreme does not hear from the Reno Riders then the Canadian Supreme will assume the rider is going to show at the Canadian Supreme and fees will not be returned.
